

# Home visits

- We will start visits on Monday, 5th September for 7 days
- Please inform us if the date given is inconvenient



# Why do we do Home Visits?

- It gives us a chance to meet informally and gather information
- We always visit in twos, so whilst one of us is talking to you, the other person can be getting to know your child

# Group Visits

- From Wednesday, 14<sup>th</sup> September the children will start coming into school in small groups
- On that visit, the children will be shown their coat peg, shown where the toilets are and have a chance to explore their new



# Starting school

- Once your child has had his group visit, he will then be ready to start school properly
- The children will come into school in small groups of 7 or 8
- This will take about 4 days



# Attending part time

- For the first few weeks, the children will be attending part time, either mornings or afternoons

# Staying to dinner ...

- From Monday, 3rd October, some of the children will start having lunch at school
- At this stage, you will have to decide whether you want your child to have a school dinner or a packed lunch
- On the first day of staying to lunch, the children will either come in for lunch and then stay for the afternoon session or attend the morning session and go home after lunch



# Staying all day

- By Friday, 7th October, the children should all be attending full time and staying to lunch
- Occasionally, things might not go to plan, so there has to be some flexibility in the process
