Dear Resident/Occupier,

Re: Works to improve the junction of A406 Bowes Road / Green Lanes / North Circular Road

As you should be aware, works have begun on the A406 Bounds Green improvement scheme. Preparatory works have started at several locations along the length of the scheme to clear land and divert utilities ahead of the construction of the main scheme.

From early August 2010 works will begin on major improvements to the footway and road at the junction of Green Lanes and the A406 North Circular Road. These works will significantly improve the pedestrian crossing facilities at the junction. The carriageway of the A406 will be widened to three lanes plus left and right filter lanes in each direction, and the traffic signals will be replaced. These works are scheduled to continue until May 2011.

Preparatory works to the junction will involve placing the existing traffic lights in barrels so they can be moved as the junction works progress. This exercise will take around one week, and during this period there will be no “green man” signals for pedestrians during the day, while the work on the signals is being undertaken. Signs will be placed to advise pedestrians of this and encourage them to use caution when using the uncontrolled crossings. The “green man” signals will be reinstated at the end of each working day. Once these works are completed, the “green man” signals will operate as normal. We will write to you once the start date of these works is confirmed so you know when to expect the changes to the crossing facilities.

Then, around the week commencing 16 August, works will start to excavate land, move kerbs to their future locations, improve the footways, and install new pedestrian crossing facilities, street lighting and traffic lights. We will write to you with more detailed information about these works closer to the time.

To minimise disruption to traffic and to local businesses and pedestrians, works are being planned in phases, working at one or two corners of the junction at a time. Work will commence at the north western corner of the junction where Green Lanes meets the A406 Bowes Road.

During this period, pedestrian access to businesses and properties will be maintained at all times. Traffic management measures will be in place throughout the works to create safe spaces for workers to operate in. We aim to avoid having to temporarily ban any traffic turns at this junction during the works however, if this is necessary, diversion routes will be put in place, clear signs will be provided for drivers and the changes will be explained to local residents and stakeholders.

The works will involve excavation of concrete and land using machinery and so there will be some associated noise disturbance. Our contractors will do their utmost to keep noise and disruption to a minimum. Working hours will be from 07:00 to 18:00, Monday to Friday and 08:00 to 16:00 Saturday.
