Money Spent so far: £14,646		
Enfield Buyback Scheme (Whole School)	£1,000	The Enfield Buyback scheme gives Hazelwood entry to all the sporting leagues and competitions; affiliation to EPSSA. It provides support and training for PE staff amongst other member of school. Health and safety and subject leader support. Entrance into the gymnastics and dance festivals.
Handball Coaching (Year 3 – 6)	£300	This club is run by a specialist Handball coach who promotes the sport to different children across year 3 to 6. The club will provide a new experience for children who do not necessarily could experience Handball outside of school. Links with other schools have been made possible through the coach and the club.
Tennis Coaching (Year 3-4 And (1-2)	£1,640 plus VAT	Throughout the beginning of autumn and then the summer months this club for year 3 & 4 and year 1 & 2 children is run by specialist tennis coaches from Primal Health Tennis Academy. It allows children to engage with tennis and give them the opportunity to use the fantastic facilities at Mayfield Tennis Club.
Golf Coaching (Year 3 – 6)	£300	Throughout the year this club is run for various children across year 3 – 6 by a specialist golf coach. The club raises the interest of golf within children and promotes certain skill sets which you do not find in other sports.
PE Subject Leader TLR	£2,613	The impact of sports coach becoming subject leader for the children will be able to organise and provide more sporting opportunities for the entire school.
PE Leader employed extra day	£5,410	PE leader employed for 5 days instead of 4 days to develop teaching and learning within gymnastics and dance. The PE leader will work alongside teachers to improve the quality of teaching in gymnastics and dance. This will help encourage children to take an interest in gymnastics and dance and improve the quality of lessons.
Table Tennis Equipment	£562.50	We run a weekly lunchtime club for years 4 and 5 to promote table tennis and give them the opportunity to play on professional tables. The children enjoy coming and we normally have a line waiting to play.

Maintenance of gymnastics equipment	£172.00	It is important to maintain health and safety standards across PE and the maintenance of the gymnastics equipment will ensure that children are safe whilst using it.
Get Active Club Equipment	£105	This club targets are overweight inactive children and buying additional resources to keep them interested and active is vital.
Gymnastics Leotards	£312.50	To ensure our children look (and feel) smart and professional when competing in the Borough Gymnastics Festival.
Yoga Staff Training	£985.00	The yoga staff training across the whole school has provided CPD for all teachers. It has further allowed them to broaden their knowledge and skills in teaching another strand of physical education to the children. The children benefit from being taught yoga and thoroughly enjoy doing it in PE lessons with their teacher.
Gymnastics Springboard	£294	Our old springboard needed replacing to ensure our children learn the correct techniques when using the springboard.
Travel to Lords Cricket	£472 (coach costs)	Children from years 4 & 5 will be going to Lords Cricket Ground for the school engagement day. They will have the opportunity to watch semi-professional cricket and take part and play cricket on the ground.
Cricket Coaching Club Year 3 & 4	£480	Throughout the summer terms months this club for year 3 & 4 is run by specialist cricket coaches from Winchmore Hill Cricket Club. It allows children to engage with cricket and further encourage them to take up cricket outside of school.
Plan for rest of funding (£4,197):		
Sports Week	£2,000	Hazelwood are planning sports week in June 2016. Money has been allocated to fund outside coaches to deliver a variety of sports to give the whole school taster sessions in different activities. This is to try and give every child the opportunities to experience a new sport or activity to engage interest.
Updating Sports Kits and equipment	£1500	Several sports team's kits need replacing. The children feel a real sense of pride when representing Hazelwood in a Hazelwood kit. We want this to continue whenever they represent the school in sport or outside of school. A selection of sports equipment also needs updating to ensure children can learn the necessary skills with official equipment.
Yoga Resources	£400	The children will be able to use yoga mats and accessories to further their understanding and skills of yoga.

Travel costs to attend fixtures/ competitions/ sporting events	£200	This is important as without this money children from Hazelwood would not be able to have as many opportunities as they do have to take part in sport.
Updating camping equipment	£160	Hazelwood have update some camping equipment so children from year 5 will continue go to Tolmers Camp each year to take part in various Outdoor and Adventurous Activities. This is important part of the curriculum to help develop confidence and team building skills.
