
Our curriculum is taught through a combination of adult led and structured learning and child-initiated learning. We provide our children with opportunities to choose activities and to learn through play in both

Tapestry is the online journal that we use to share images and observations of your child's learning and progress with you.


It will allow us to build up a record of your child's experiences and learning during their time with us that you can view at home.




Safe Usage and Parent Accounts


What will you see?



Adding to your child's Journal

To help all staff know what your children can do and what they are interested in, you can provide observations from home. This could be something they have experienced with you, something new they can do or something exciting they wish to share with us. This helps to build up the bigger picture of your child

Commenting on observations

We ask you to contribute to your children learning journey by commenting on any observations and adding your own home experiences.

Focus weeks

Children will have 2 focus weeks per year – this is when staff will pay particular attention to your child's learning and development and feedback to you at the end of the week.

Cycle 1 is Autumn 2/Spring 1 & Cycle 2 is Spring 2/Summer 1.

Communicating with teachers

We ask that should you need to speak with your child teacher email the school office or speak to them at the end of the school day and do not communicate via Tapestry observations.







Tablet app - It may look slightly different on a tablet but the functions are the same
